



Great Lakes Coed Soccer League Post-Season Tournament Appendix C

PLAYER MOVEMENT RULE

- A. Players may be added to a participating tournament team only if their originally rostered team is not participating in the tournament.
- B. A player whose originally rostered team is participating in the tournament may not transfer or be a guest player for another team.
- C. When a club has multiple participating teams within the same age group and has players available from non-participating teams, those players shall be assigned to participating teams by the Tournament/League Registrar.
 - a. Assignments will be made in a manner intended to maintain balance.
 - b. Coaches/Clubs may request players, however the final placement decision rests solely with the Tournament/League Registrar.
- D. If two or more teams from the same club are unable to field sufficient numbers independently and wish to participate, the teams may combine to form a single tournament team with approval from the tournament director.
- E. Players may play up to an older age group in accordance with the league's existing rules. Players may not play down to a younger age group, even if they are age eligible.
 - a. For example, if a player is technically a U13 aged player and chooses to play up to U15 during the regular season, they may not play in the U13 age group in the tournament.
- F. All tournament rosters must be submitted by the deadline established by the Tournament Director. Once approved, rosters are considered frozen and may only be changed with approval from the Tournament Director due to extenuating circumstances.
- G. The Tournament Director reserves the right to deny any roster or player movement requests that are determined to be inconsistent with the recreational philosophy of the tournament
